
## Release Notes

### ACS Online Release 7.0

**Overview:** Release 7.0 of the ACS Online application provides several extensions to existing functionality that have been added in response to meet growing needs in new vertical markets served by Brivo's product lines. These include: support for up to 50 custom-defined fields associated with users in your account; the ability for Assistant Administrators to create and edit site-specific schedules for their facilities.

### Up to 50 Custom Fields

The Brivo ACS Online application now supports up to 50 custom fields for tracking information associated with users defined in your User Directory. Management tools for this new functionality include the ability to control and rearrange the order in which these custom fields appear, as well as which fields appear on the define user page, and which field appear on an 'extended view' page that contains as many as 50 of the newly defined fields.

All 50 fields may now be populated through Brivo's data upload service, available through Brivo Technical Support.

### Site-Specific Schedules for Assistant Administrators

Previous versions of the Brivo ACS Online application allowed only Senior Administrators and above to create and edit schedules governing Door Timers, Device Schedules, Notifications, and Groups. This privilege was reserved for these high-level administrators because Schedules may extend across multiple sites—including sites beyond the rights of a particular Assistant Administrator who may wish to view or use these schedules.

To allow Assistant Administrators to create and managed Schedules consistent with their site-level privileges, the ACS application now includes a new site-specific schedules type for ACS5000 control panels. The new schedules type is accessible to

Assistant Administrators, now with all the Door, Device, Holiday, and Notification functionality previously available only to higher level administrators on multi-site schedules. The Schedules function just like existing Schedules, except that they are restricted to the Site for which they were created.

With the addition of this powerful new feature, Assistant Administrators now have a larger toolset at their disposal for managing their own locale, region, or facility.

This feature addition enables greater local administration of door schedules for individual sites, while still providing oversight of all access control activities for the Senior and Master Administrators within an account.
