## Release Notes

### ACS Online Release 7.1.0


**Overview:** Release 7.1.0 of the ACS Online application offers enhanced access control and customized reporting capabilities. Increased security is provided via two new functions: Group Activated Schedules and Two-Factor Credentials. Group Activated Schedules let you link a schedule to a specific group of users, so that until a member of that group accesses a door or device it remains locked to all other users who also use that schedule. With Two-Factor Credentials, you can require that a user provide both a security card and a PIN to gain access to a door or device. Finally, the new reporting functionality allows you to specify exactly what user properties you want to view and for what subset of users.

### Group Activated Schedules

Brivo ACS Online has always allowed you to control access to a door or device by schedule, but now you can add group affiliation to that access relationship as well. By allowing you to link a schedule to a specific group of users, Brivo has enabled two new functionalities: First-Person-In and Supervisor-on-Site.

With First-Person-In, the Administrator assigns a specific group of users to be the *enabling* group for a schedule. Only when a member of that group presents a valid credential does the schedule become active. Until the schedule is activated in this way, there is no access to any door with which the schedule is associated.

Closely related to First-Person-In is the concept of Supervisor-on-Site. Here, the Administrator defines a group of supervisors who must be present at a location before any devices at that site can be used. Again, only when a member of the specified group presents a valid credential does the schedule controlling access to the devices become active. This functionality is ideally suited for retail and warehouse environments where a supervisor is required to be on site for insurance reasons.



## Two-Factor Credentials

Brivo has always supported the use of either security cards or keypad readers, but with this new release of ACS Online both types of credentials may be assigned to an individual user for added security.

The Administrator simply creates a schedule that indicates when both types of credentials are required and then links that schedule to the desired doors and/or programmable devices. When the schedule is active, users will need to present both a card and a valid PIN to gain access. When the schedule is inactive the traditional one-factor credential is all that is required.


