
ACS WebService™ Release 7.3

Overview: With Release 7.3 of ACS WebService, you can now generate customized employee badges, to be used for both identification and access purposes. This release also provides enhancements to Brivo's digital video recording function by adding support for the American Dynamics Intellex® system. Finally, version 7.3 will be available in both Spanish and French.

Badging

Brivo ACS WebService version 7.3 comes preloaded with a set of standardized badge templates that you can customize to meet the needs of your organization. Create a layout displaying your corporate logo as well as information such as your company name and address, and then individualize each badge with employee data already maintained in your ACS WebService account.

Badge identification photos come from the user profile, and can be either imported from images already stored on your system or captured using a Logitech Orbit MP QuickCam®. Brivo currently supports the Magicard Tango 2e ID card printer for badge production.



Enhanced DVR Support

The video surveillance functionality in ACS WebService is enhanced in version 7.3 to include support for American Dynamics Intellex® DVR on ADT Select Entry systems. Other Brivo ACS WebService systems support the Dedicated Micros Digital Sprite 2.

Spanish Release

In addition to the English and French versions of ACS WebService, Brivo now offers a Spanish release of its #1 selling access control system.
