ACS WebService® Release 7.7

Overview: Release 7.7 provides enhancements to schedule creation, email notifications for Lockdown, and an optional firmware upgrade. This release also provides the option for users to import badge images en masse.

Mass Image Import

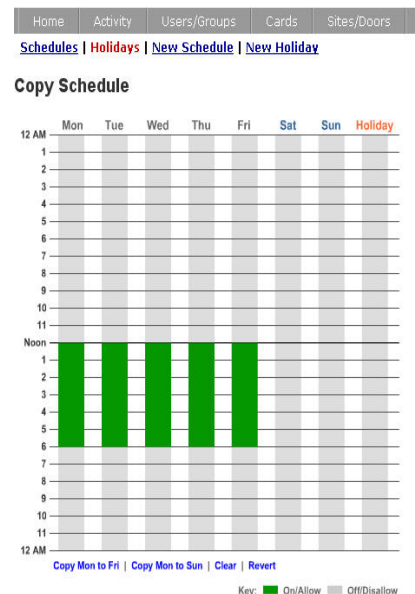
As part of Brivo's Data Upload service, ACS WebServices offers customers the service of importing images for badges en masse. This feature is particularly helpful for the customer who was previously using another badging system. For more details on this feature, customers should contact their local sales representative.

Copy Schedule

This feature allows customers to replicate current schedules. For instance, a user may copy a universal schedule in order to create a site schedule in one simple step.

Lockdown Email

Now when an administrator puts an account into Lockdown, an email is sent to the email address that is in the Account Section that was specified when the account was created. This is not a notification rule and cannot be configured, an aspect of the feature that is beneficial for two reasons: if an account is in Lockdown for an emergency, the account owner is notified via email. Additionally, this feature safeguards against an incident in which the account is accidentally put into Lockdown without an administrator's knowledge. By doing so, this feature provides an added layer of traceability to the Lockdown feature.
