
## Release Notes

### ACS WebService® Release 7.9.1

**Overview:** In this release, Brivo offers several improvements to the video service for ACS WebService. Release 7.9.1 marks the launch of the beta version of Hosted Video Service, as well as the addition of both Pelco and Matrix DVRs to our traditional DVR offering.\*

#### Hosted Video (Beta) and DVR Additions

Brivo's Hosted Video Service enables WebService users to view live video and activity-based playback at five frames per second, and can also store video footage on Brivo's Hosted Video server for up to seven days. The only required equipment for this service is a compatible IP-based camera. To participate, please contact your sales representative.
