## Release Notes

### ACS OnSite Aparato™ Release 3.0.3

**Overview:** This release introduces a cleaner and more efficient interface for the Aparato. This release also introduces Reporting, a query tool for both pre-defined and newly created reports. Also, this release introduces the concept of User Aliases, allowing a single user to be shared in multiple sub-accounts. This release also introduces the ability to print two-sided badges on supported printers.

#### **Enhanced Interface**

The Aparato interface has been improved to make using the system more efficient. The more frequently used sections of the product are more accessible, and items used primarily during initial account setup are consolidated in the Configuration menu.

#### **Reporting**

This version adds a new query tool for quickly generating commonly run reports. A number of standard reports have been pre-defined so that they can be used immediately. These pre-defined reports can be copied and customized to form a new report as desired. The new reporting tool also allows for the creation and generation of custom reports. The new scheduling function allows reports to be run on a defined schedule. The report output can be sent to individual Administrators via email or stored on an external server. Emailed reports are individually tailored to each Administrators' security level.

#### **User Aliases**

User aliases are a new way to place a single User in multiple sub-accounts. The User name, user photo, credentials, and dates work across permissions granted in multiple sub-accounts. The advantage to this is that it allows each account to manage its own set of permissions on a given User with certain restrictions.

#### **Two-sided Badge Printing**

This new feature allows for two-sided badge printing on supported printers. The badge printer must have dual-sided capability.
