ACS WebService® 10.7

Overview: The WebService 10.7 release introduces new product support for IPDC and Brivo Mobile (Beta) as well as many enhancements to existing features sets. Feature enhancements include new reporting parameters and OVR Video enhancements.

Reporting Enhancements

Two new enhancements are introduced to the existing reports engine for filtering report data. Report criteria can now be edited and saved for future use. Filtering is now possible on several fields, such as All Users, Active Users, Inactive Users, Doors, Devices, Control Panel, Group Directory, Elevator, Account, Holiday, First/Last Access, Daily Summary, and Unused Credential.

Enhanced Credential Security*

'Card Required' credential settings are now supported. When enabled at the door, users with privileges to that door will need to present a card credential to gain access during the scheduled period. The use of a PIN alone will not be sufficient.

OVR Video Enhancement

"Video exclusion zones" for motion setup can now be created. Administrators will have the ability to limit what areas of the image triggers motion detection events.

User Interface Enhancements

Improvements to the ACS WebService interface include the addition of buttons for account management functions, including New User, New Group, New Site, Edit Site, and more. Additionally, select account management operations have been grouped together to streamline the user interface. For example, under the Site page a "More Operations" button has been added to group together Add Door, Add Device, Add Floor and View History. The "My Reports" page has now been divided into three management pages for easier use and better visibility.

IP Door Controller (IPDC) Support

Updates to WebService have been made to support the IPDC. It is the latest innovation in the Brivo hardware line, allowing the choice of one or two door models in a compact form factor.

Brivo Mobile (Beta)

This beta version of Brivo Mobile can be viewed at m.brivo.com. Master Administrators will have the ability to watch video clips and unlock doors directly from a mobile browser.
