Release Notes

ACS WebService™ Release 9.2

Overview: This release provides enhancements to the ability to edit privileges for groups and enables bulk editing permissions for assistant administrators. OVR WebService™ now offers time-based playback functionality. This release also offers further DVR support with the addition of the Samsung SHR DVR line.

Group and Site Privileges

Brivo is pleased to announce enhancements to the ability to edit privileges for groups in ACS WebService. While users can still view the list of all sites and their permissions on one page, administrators can now also filter the list to quickly display certain groups of data.

This release also offers more options for master and senior administrators when assigning permissions to assistant administrators. Master and senior administrators can now enable assistant administrators to edit permissions in bulk for accounts with extensive groups and sites. Instead of manually selecting individual boxes to apply groups and sites, assistant administrators can now simultaneously assign the same permissions to a site or group. This feature makes it easier for the administrators to add the same permissions to multiple sites or groups at a time.

OVR WebService

OVR WebService now allows users to jump to a point in time to view video that is not associated with an event in the Activity Log. The playback clip can be viewed and downloaded as a file.
